WHITE BOTTLES

* Vinkara Narince Reserve 2012 (Turkey) \$67.00

Dry full-bodied, elegant and well balance, with notes of vanilla, spiced wood, floral and minerality.

* Corvus Karga, Cavus/Muscat 2015 (Turkey) \$44.00

Characterized by a blend of tropical fruit and mineral flavors, hints of grapefruit and pineapple with a subtle buttery finish. This is an unoaked gem.

ROSÉ BOTTLE

* Kayra Rosé, Kalecik Karası. Aegean Region, 2017 (Turkey) \$44.00

Light-bodied and dry Rosé with strawberry hues, notes of raspberry, summer fruits and a smooth refreshing finish.

RED BOTTLES

*Vinkara Boğazkere Reserve 2012 (Turkey) \$ 80.00

Medium-bodied, light oak, hints of toasted almonds and red fruits, flavors of bitter chocolate and black cherry with a smooth divine finish.

*Stobi Veritas Reserve Tikves 2015 (Macedonia) \$60.00

Vranec

The word Vranec means strong, black and powerful horse (black stallion), which is why the wine is known also as black wine in Macedonia. Full body with lots of tannin dry wine, very complex, jummy and has a deep inky purple color with crushed blackberry flavors. Bouquet of morello cherry overlaid with notes of roast coffee and dark bitter chocolate. Rich in extract with a structure ready to impress.

*Suvla Grand Reserve 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon (Turkey) \$140.00

Matured in oak barrels for 12 months. Full-bodied, characterized by the complexity and persistence of its bouquet of blackberries, mocha, cigar box and leather. Peppery elements, leading to a long dry finish.

*Karma Öküzgözü/Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 (Turkey) \$72.00

Two grapes of strong character complement one another and lend bouquets that strengthen by aging, and thus yield a balanced combination. With its full-body, long finish and powerful, tannic structure it invokes the aromas of red fruits, vanilla, cinnamon and caramel exhibiting some fruity aromas of blackberry and spice.

*Massaya Gold 2010 (Lebanon) \$124.00

Cabernet Sauvignon/Mourvedre/Syrah.

A bold, complex and dry wine, with hints of currant, blackberry, cherry, spicy oak, vanilla and smoked toast. Combined with aromas of cedar, cigar box, thyme, cinnamon, black pepper, spice box and sun-dried fruit.

*Corvus Blend Nö5 2008 (Turkey) \$135.00

Cabernet Franc/Syrah/Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon.

Sun-drenched soil has yielded a complex wine with hints of red and black berries, with aromas of a box full of Mediterranean herbs and spices. Rich, dark and deep in its flavors. Velvety and full-bodied but not unwieldy, leading to a lovely freshness and ripe tannins providing the perfect amount of grip.

*Sevilen Centum Syrah 2009 (Turkey) \$135.00

Hints of blueberry and blackberry accompanied by soft tannins. Full-bodied with a jammy mouthfeel. Pleasant acidity balances this exceptional wine.



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
